TASTING NOTES

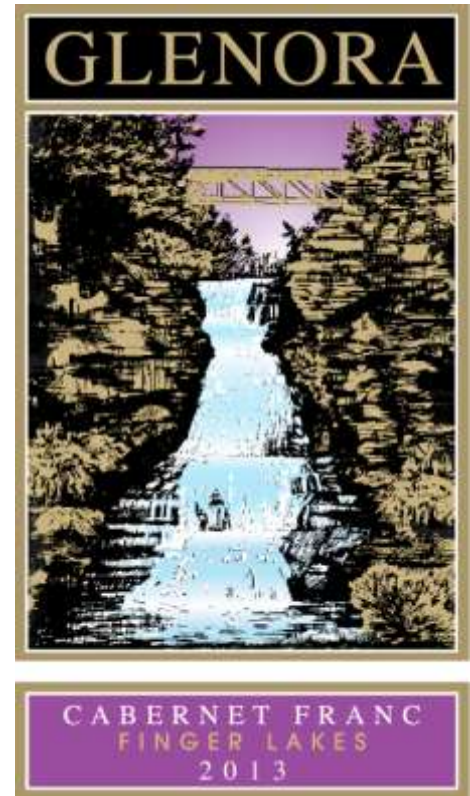
Our 2013 Cabernet Franc is a full-bodied, rich red wine, with lingering finish and gentle tannins. This wine is made from grapes in specially selected vineyards in the Finger Lakes appellation. Best served with red meats, cheese and grilled vegetables.

The first winery on Seneca Lake and a pioneer of New York's Finger Lakes wine region.
