The Glenora Moscato is made from Valvin Muscat, naturally flavorful grapes that have notes of apricot, orange blossom, and jasmine tea. This semi-sweet wine is bright and clean with moderately low alcohol. This wine should be enjoyed with spicy Asian cuisine, gourmet cheese and light desserts such as fruit tarts and crème brulee.

It is also great served ice cold on a hot day.
