### TASTING NOTES

Rich and flavorful, with layers of poached Bosc pears, cherries, hazelnuts, caramel, and a lovely touch of lemongrass carry through to a long finish in the Cabernet Franc from Glenora Wine Cellars. The grapes for this wine were picked on January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at 15 degrees F. They were immediately pressed while frozen, yielding a tiny amount of juice at 46% sugar. A long, cool fermentation retained the full complexity of flavors. Enjoy after a meal with a rich dessert or
