TASTING NOTES

Rich and flavorful, with layers of poached Bosc pears, cherries, hazelnuts, caramel, and a lovely touch of lemongrass carry through to a long finish in the Cabernet Franc from Glenora Wine Cellars. The grapes for this wine were picked on January 7th, 2014 at 15 degrees F. They were immediately pressed while frozen, yielding a tiny amount of juice at 46% sugar. A long, cool fermentation retained the full complexity of flavors. Enjoy after a meal with a rich dessert or
