

2014 Riesling Ice Wine

TASTING NOTES

Poached apricots, a touch of candied lemon, and caramel flavors intertwine in the Riesling Ice Wine from Glenora. This wine has a very rich, full body with a lively finish. The grapes for this wine were picked on February 11, 2014, at 15 degrees F. They were immediately pressed while frozen, yielding a tiny amount of juice at 42% sugar. A long, cool fermentation retained the full complexity of flavors.

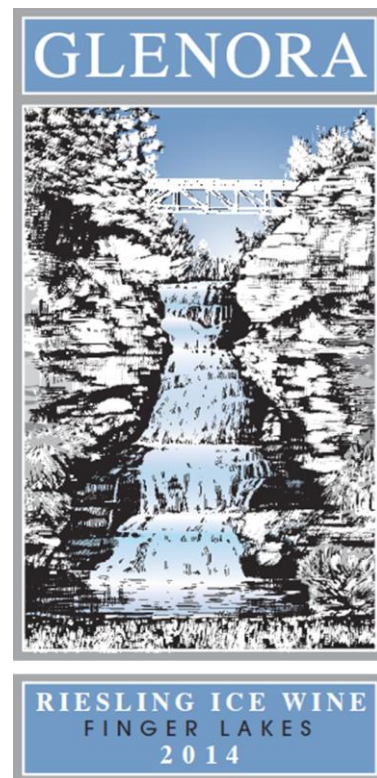
