The Glenora Willow White wine is a pleasant, slightly sweet wine that has aromas of fresh grapes.

The labels on this bottle are made with an environmentally friendly “Green” product called TerraSkin®, which is a paper made from stone instead of trees. TerraSkin® is produced without water or toxic bleaching chemicals and uses 50% less energy than the production of paper.
